Jennifer Mason, founder of The Alabaster Gift, will speak on how to protect your children and grandchildren.

Jennifer Mason - I am the Founder and Executive Director of The Alabaster Gift. Established in 2013, The Alabaster Gift is a nonprofit 501c3 anti-human trafficking organization providing services to victims of sexual and labor trafficking including exploitation. Additionally, we are dedicated to prayer, training, education and awareness. I am a pastor, currently transferring my license to the Assemblies of God Church. I served previously for 9 years as a staff pastor in the Wesleyan Church within the traditional ministry realm. I am certified through FFAST (Faith Alliance Against Slavery and Trafficking) as a Train the Trainer, completed Michigan Human Trafficking Task Force as Train the Trainer, certified by The Human Trafficking Training Institute, completed Trauma-Informed Care by No Boundaries International/Lori Basey, accomplished CCDA Immersion Training (Christian Community Development Association) and affiliated with the WJN (Wesleyan Justice Network).
